## Cases on Crimes Against the Person

1. Andy, a freshman, is in love with Jennifer, another freshman. Andy sneaks up on Jennifer in the commons and kisses her. What result?
2. D, an eighteen year old bodybuilder, comes upon an elderly lady, pulls out a toy pistol and says "This is it for you, old lady!" He pulls the trigger, a noise is made, and D runs off laughing. What result?
3. Kevin and Bill want to date Jane. Kevin is tired of Bill's advances on "his girl." Kevin calls Bill on the phone and says "I'm going to blow your head off." What result?
4. V claimed that she had sex with D only because he had a gun. V never saw the gun for the entire two plus hours the two were together and D never mentioned the gun again. V admits that she kissed D goodbye. What result? *People v. Taylor*, 268 N.E.2d 865 (Ill. 1961).
5. During the Klein Oak-Klein Forest basketball game, a vicious KF guard smacks Chris Collins in the face with an elbow. What result?
6. In the act of robbing a Circle K, D clubs the cashier over the head with a revolver. What result?
7. D has sexual intercourse with his wife, V. V contends that the two were arguing for several days beforehand and that the intercourse was forced upon her. D does not contest V's reluctance but he claims he is entitled to his conjugal rights. What result?
8. In fear of being late to class, James runs around a corner and into a Strutter. What result?
9. D, a 30 year old man, attempts to rape a female geriatric patient. Due to mental disease, the victim did not know what was happening. D was stopped before he could commit the rape. What result?
10. D intends to strike a blow to V's face, but does not intend to do serious injury to V. Unfortunately, D is wearing a ring on his hand; the ring takes out V's eye when the blow is struck. What result?
11. D's baby dropped from her womb into a toilet bowl. It did not cry and she did not tie its umbilical cord. Evidence indicated that the baby breathed after its head came out from the womb, but that the baby was dead before the birthing process was finished. What result? *People v. Chavez*, 176 P.2d 92 (Cal.App.1947).
12. D learned that his estranged wife was pregnant by another man. He accosted her, saying "I'm going to stomp it out of you", and shoved his knee into her abdomen, fracturing the baby's skull. The baby was stillborn. Medical evidence indicated that at the time of D's attack, the fetus (28 weeks) was viable. What result? *Keeler v. Superior Court*, 470 P.2d 617 (Cal.1970).
